# NCAE-C K-12 RING Project

The NCAE-C K-12 RING project, led by University of Alabama Huntsville and Moraine Valley Community College, continues to work in developing an online cybersecurity course for high school students.

The UAH coalition is leading the curriculum development portion while the Moraine Valley coalition develops and inserts interactive activities and labs into the curricular units. Students will also have access to an online textbook created in partnership with Cisco Network Academy. Other aspects of the project include the K12 CyberTalk show (https://k12cybertalk.org/) and the development of a student honor society.

The pilot course will be taught beginning August 2021 and the curriculum will be released for distribution in 2022. The RING team will be actively marketing and recruiting for the pilot course in the spring and summer months.
