Summer 2021

The summer of 2021 was a busy one for academic institutions, hosting GenCyber programs nationwide.

- 157 GenCyber programs, with about
 70 percent of those held in a virtual format
- 111 student camps, 43 teachercamps, and three combination camps
- 46 states, plus DC, and Puerto Rico

As usual, academic institutions channeled their creativity and innovation to find new ways in teaching and introducing students to the world of cybersecurity.

This included GenCyber camps that focused on students who are deaf or hard of hearing, the visually impaired, part of the Junior ROTC program, females, and under-represented minorities. There was even a GenCyber camp hosted in Portuguese!
