

CAE-C SouthWest Regional Hub Exercise

Saturday, November 6, 2021 from 1 – 5 pm CT

Hosted by San Antonio College and the University of Texas at San Antonio in collaboration with NUARI

This event is a virtual Distributed Tabletop Exercise, planned for 4 hours and will leverage Zoom and NUARI's DECIDE[®] platform. Introductory Exercise play is open to all Undergraduate students of the SouthWest Regional Hub Institutions. The exercise will provide Cybersecurity, Situational Assessment, Public Information and Warning, Intelligence and Information Sharing response exposure.

The goals of the exercise are:

- Gain greater understanding of key roles and responsibilities during executive cyber response.
- Gain and increased understanding of the complexities of an executive cyber response.

Participants (Undergraduate students) will be aligned to roles commonly found in a large organization's "C-Suite," as well as important support roles (e.g., legal counsel and public information) and will focus on the timeframe AFTER a data breach within their organization. Participants will share their own perspective(s), within their teams and other supporting organizations, to collaborate on the "Board" response.

In preparation for the Exercise, **all** participants will be required to attend one of two participant training sessions. Sessions will be held virtually and will require laptop and audio connectivity. Session links will be provided once registration has been confirmed. Please indicate which session you will attend during your registration.

Participant Training Session 2: Thursday, November 4, 2021 from 7 – 8 pm CT

Facilitators/Evaluators will be required to attend a Training session on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 from 1 – 2 pm CT. Participation in any of the additional Participant training sessions is optional.

** Notes**

- Each Role on a team **may** have two people assigned who will be able to collaborate within DECIDE for their responses during the exercise. Duplication allows some support for each student and ensures that all teams are complete if an individual participant should back out of the event.
- All teams will have a facilitator/evaluator assigned to them
 - **Facilitators:** Provide situation updates and moderate discussions. They also provide additional information or resolve questions as required.
 - **Evaluators:** Are assigned to observe and document certain objectives during the exercise.
